On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide

The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration eligibility Documents, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. This action is taken under the authority of section 4 (g)(2)(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Registration under this section does not eliminate the need for control reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at anytime to maintain the registration of your product. With regards to labeling, you must make the labeling changes listed below.

1. Based upon the toxicological properties of this product and upon PR Notice 2000-3 (Released for Public Comment 4/11/00), the header "Statement of Practical Treatment" should be replaced with the header "First Aid." The First Aid statements should be revised to read as follows:

"IF SWALLOWED:

Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advise. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:

Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES:

Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

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Since this product is listed as having an acute inhalation toxicity of category IV, no treatment statements are required. If you wish to place additional treatment statements on the label, the statement should read as follows, per PR Notice 2000-3.

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IF INHALED:

Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advise."

- 2. Your product is also required to have a "Note to Physician." The Note to Physician should be located directly below your "First Aid" statement and should contain the following information:
- Technical information on symptomatology;
- Use of supportive treatments to maintain life functions;
- Medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide;
- Company telephone number to specific medical personnel who can provide specialized medical advice.
- 3. The header "Hazards to Humans" should be modified to read "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals." Replace the statement "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling" with the statement "Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."
- 4. Under the header "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" add the following statements: "Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) (please use this format)

Handlers must wear: Long sleeved shirt and pants Shoes and socks chemical resistant gloves

USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PE separately from other laundry.

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

Remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin - Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

If in eyes - Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

Precautionary Statements Hazards to Humans CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing dust.
