**APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS** Pour along back fine and down lace. Apply 1/2 ff. oz. per 100 lbs. body weight of animal, up to a maximum of 5 ft. oz. for any one animal to lift Lice, Horn Files and Face Files. Aids in the insecticidal control of Horse Files, Stable Files, Mosquitoes, Black Files and Ticks on lactating and non-lactating dairy cattle, beef cattle, calves and sheep. For Kads on sheep, pour along back line over-neck, shoulders and rump. Apply 1/4 ft; oz. per 50 lbs. body weight of animal, up to a maximum of 3 ft, oz. for any one animal.

Repeat treatment as needed, but not more than once every two weeks. For optimum insecticidal effectiveness against lice, a double treatment at 14 day intervels is recommended. NOTE: This product is not effective for grub control on cattle.

Do not contraminate water, load or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage — Keep container seeled when not in use. Do not store near food or feed.

Pesticide Disposal — Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal — Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a senitary landfill or incineration, or if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning.
