IMPORTANT: This is a highly concentrated formulation. Use only with an accurate measuring container or applicator.

Apply to: Lactating and Non lactating Dairy Cattle and Beef Cattle.

Application Instructions Controls susceptible Horn Flies for up to Pour-On Dosage: Pour from poll down 6 weeks. Controls Lice. Aids in control neck and over shoulders. Apply 1.5 mL per 100 lbs body weight to a maximum of Face Flies, Deer Flies, Horse Flies, Stable Flies, House Flies, Mosquitoes, of 15 mL per animal (1mL = 1 cc) and Black Flies. (30mL = 1 oz). Repeat treatment as needed, but not more often than once every 2 weeks. For optimum lice control, two treatments at a 14 day interval are recommended.

DO NOT USE ON HORSES.

SPECIAL NOTE: This product is not effective in controlling grubs.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage and Spill Procedures: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical
