For adequate control of horn flies, attach one tag per animal. For optimum control of horn flies, control of ear ticks, and as an aid in the control of face flies, lice, stable flies and house flies, attach one tag to 'ch ear (two per animal). Replace as cessary. This product has been proven to be effective against pyrethroid resistant horn flies for up to five months. Apply as indicated (Figures 1-5). Calves less than 3 months of age should not be tagged as ear damage may result. Remove tag prior to slaughter.






Figure 3. Figure 4.

Position tag on the inner flat surface in center of ear. Do not allow shaft of the rivet to penetrate any cartilage rib or blood vessel or ear damage may result. We recommend that tag be rotated at a 90° angle (Fig. 3) for ease of application. Tag may also be extended outward from the plier in a straight manner (Fig. 4).
