Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing dust. Do not get in eyes or on tender parts of body or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Call a physician or poison control center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting. **If Inhaled:** Remove person to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention. **If on Skin:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **If in Eyes:** Wash with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Keep container tightly sealed. Store indoors in an upright position and in a cool, dry place. If container is damaged, check for any spillage. If spilled, sweep up and transfer contents into another suitable container or dispose of spillage as directed below. Avoid contamination with other chemicals.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
