Recommended for control

of San Jose Scale on peach, plum, pear and apple trees, for spider mites (citrus red mite, Texas citrus mite, 6-spotted mite) and scale (California and Florida red scale, brown soft scale, black scale) in citrus and for Phylloxera and obscur scale on pecan trees. May be used as a dormant, delayed dormant or summer oil; when combined with nicotine sulfate meets Texas State recommendation for controlling the pecan nut case bearer.

APPLICATION

CHEX-OUT DORMATOL may be applied to trees with small hand units or with large power driven spray units. Provide continuous mixing or mechanical agitation during application to insure even application of the emulsion. TOTAL COVERAGE and wetting of all parts of the tree are essential to obtain maximum effectiveness with spray oils. After use flush equipment with fresh water.

Do not mix with sulfur or apply within 30 days after a sulfur treatment. Do not mix with pesticides incompatible with oil.

DIRECTIONS

The required amount of water should be placed in a clean tank or suitable container, the amount of **Dormant Oil Spray** added and mixed thoroughly to produce a uniform milky emulsion.

Quantity of Spray Oil Per 100 Gallons of Water\*

Dormant	3 - 4 Gallons
Delayed Dormant	1 - 2 Gallons
Summer	1 1/2 - 1-3/4 Gallons

\*Consult county or state agricultural advisor for exact state recommendations.

**Other Pesticides.** Emulsions of **Dormant Oil Spray** may be used as a carrier for appropriate approved insecticides and fungicides which can be applied to give a uniform spray.

**Pecan nut case bearer:** Use pint of 40% nicotine sulfate and 2 quarts of **Dormant Oil Spray** over 100 gallons of water. Spray before first generation of larvae enter the nuts — between April 20 and May 25, depending upon location.

**Pecan Phylloxera:** Use 3-1/2 gallons **Dormant Oil Spray** per 100 gallons of water during dormant season.

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed.

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap smaller container in newspaper and place in trash can for disposal. Destroy larger containers by perforating or crushing and bury in deep, cropland away from domestic water supplies. Use this product only as specified on the label.
