

GENERAL INFORMATION

2.0% Ciodrin® Insecticide Cattle Spray Solution is a specially prepared ready-to-use insecticide suitable for use in conventional hand, power, or automatic spray equipment. 2.0% Ciodrin® Insecticide Cattle Spray Solution is approved for lactating dairy animals. No feed-off period is necessary when used on beef animals. Apply with hand power or automatic equipment to moisten the hair only and not in excess of 2 fluid ounces daily per animal.

NOTE: Do not wet the skin due to possible skin irritation. Do not apply regularly to calves under 6 months of age. Brahman cattle should not be treated as they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates.

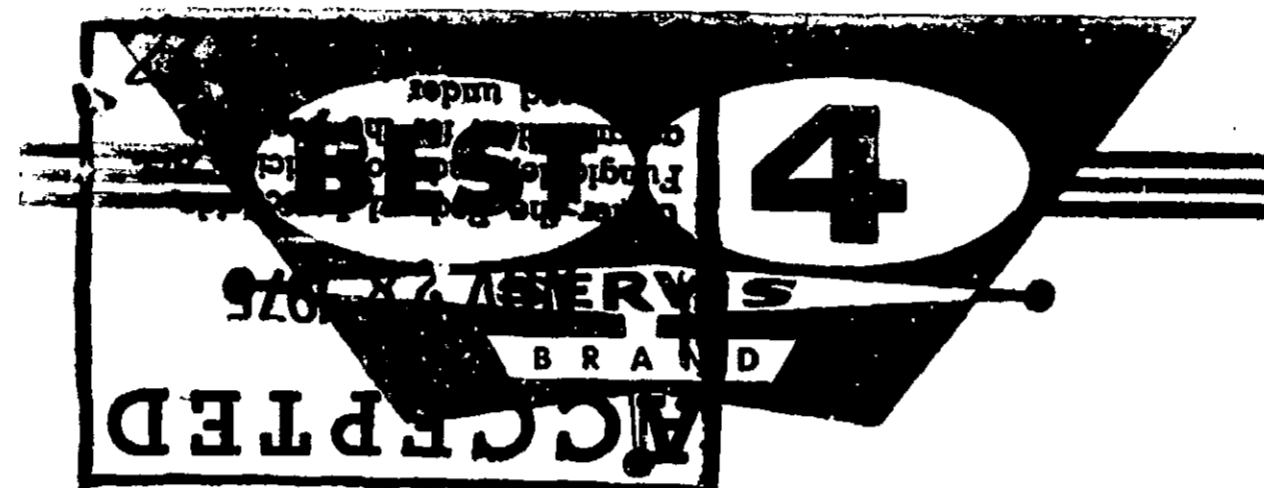
For the control of the specified insects attacking animals, apply in accordance with State and Federal recommendations.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

LACTATING DAIRY AND BEEF ANIMALS: Flies (Horn Fly, Stable Fly, Face Fly, House Fly): For the control of horn flies, stable flies, face flies, and house flies, make a light application of 2.0% Ciodrin® Insecticide Cattle Spray Solution daily as a fine mist to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal, including the legs.

NOTE: Do not treat animals within one day of slaughter. Do not apply dermally in combination with Trichlorofon.
