

**GENERAL DIRECTIONS**

DDVP Super is a specially prepared concentrate for use in conventional application equipment. Dilute 2.5 oz. of concentrate with water to make a gallon of 0.5% DDVP Emulsion.

**DIRECTIONS to control:** Roaches, ants, silverfish, spiders, etc. to be applied by PEST CONTROL OPERATORS ONLY. Apply with low pressure sprayer to localized areas insects may infest. Treat infested areas around base boards, cracks, walls, door and window frames, and localized areas of floors. Do not apply to areas which will be contacted frequently by children, and do not allow them in treated areas until surfaces are dry.

**LOGGING:** To be applied by, or under the directions of trained personnel. Dairy Barns, Stables, Feeding Pens, Outdoor Areas—Mix 2 qts. in 15 gals. fuel oil for logging. One gallon of solution will fog (4,000' cubic ft.) or 2 qts. in 50 gallons water for mist blowers. Do not treat areas where food or feed crops are growing. Control house flies, mosquitoes, and gnats present at time of application only. Do not contaminate milk or milking utensils, nor use in areas where animals have received application within 24 hours.

**PRECAUTIONS FOR USING**

DDVP Super and the dilute emulsion droplets in mist. The respiratory irritation must be observed when handling them. See antidote and warnings below.

Store the concentrate in a safe place. Children or animals must not be able to reach or handle the concentrate or dilute emulsion. It is recommended that only the amount of diluted emulsion be prepared for the area to be treated that will be used immediately.

Mix the concentrate with water in a glass or well ventilated area. Wash hands after use. Do not use in areas where children or animals are present.

Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water; get medical attention. If poisoning should occur, CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. ATROPINE IS ANTI-DOTE. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles when handling concentrate to prepare emulsions. During fogging or mist spraying applications, wear a mask or respirator approved by the U. S. Dept. of Agriculture for use with DDVP. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before re-use.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Do not re-use empty drums. Return to drum conditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying with waste.

**ANTIDOTE AND FIRST AID TREATMENT**

Atropine is the emergency antidote for DDVP insecticide poisoning. Consult your Physician about obtaining an adequate supply of 1/100 grain Atropine tablets for emergency use. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY IN ALL CASES OF SUSPECTED POISONING.

**INTERNAL:** If the material has been swallowed, induce vomiting immediately. Give 1 tablespoon of salt in a glass of water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**EXTERNAL:** If the material has been spilled on the skin, immediately remove patient from the vicinity of the insecticide, remove all contaminated clothing, and wash skin with soap and running water. If the material gets into the eyes, wash immediately with running water for at least 15 minutes.
