

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

DDVP Super is a specially prepared concentrate for use in conventional application equipment. Dilute 2.5 oz. of Concentrate with water to make a gallon of 5% DDVP Emulsion. DIRECTIONS to control: Roaches, ants, Silverfish, Spiders, etc. to be applied by PROFESSIONAL OPERATORS ONLY. Apply with low pressure sprayer to localized areas insects may infest. Treat infested areas around baseboards, cracks, walls, door and window frames, and localized areas of floors. Do not apply to areas which will be visited frequently by children and do not allow them untreated areas until surfaces are dry.

LOGGING: To be applied by, or under the directions of trained personnel. Barns, Stables, Feeding Pens, Outdoor Areas - Mix 2 qts. in 15 gals. fuel oil for fogging one gallon of solution will fog 4,000 cubic ft., or 2 qts. in 50 gallons water for misting. Do not treat areas where feed or feed crops are growing. Controls house flies, mosquitoes and gnats present at time of application only. Do not contaminate milk or milking utensils, nor use in areas where animals have recently undergone application within 8 hours.

PARTICULARS FOR USING


DDVP Super and the diluted emulsion are poison. Therefore, precautions must be observed when handling them. See antidote and warnings below.

Store the Concentrate in a sealed area. Children or animals must not be able to reach the Concentrate or diluted emulsion. It is recommended that only the amount of treated residue be removed from the concentrate that will be used during day.

Mix the concentrated water dilution in a well ventilated area. Wash off the skin if the material gets onto it. Rinse with water before storing away.

Do not drink water, eat, or smoke, or engage in any other activity that may affect the lungs.

DDVP Super is a poison. Avoid contact with eyes or skin. If you get this product in your eyes, wash out immediately. If you get it on your skin, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. If you inhale spray mist, move to fresh air, remove contaminated clothing and



wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water, get medical attention. If poisoning should occur, CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. ATROPOLINE IS ANTIODOTE. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles when handling concentrate to prepare emulsions. During fogging or mist spraying applications, wear a mask or respirator approved by the U. S. Dept. of Agriculture for use with DDVP. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before re-use.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Do not re-seal empty drums. Return to drainer, conditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying with wastes.

ANTIODE AND FIRST AID TREATMENT

Atropine is the emergency antidote for DDVP insecticide poisoning. Consult your Physician about obtaining an adequate supply of 1/100 grain Atropine tablets for emergency use. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY IN ALL CASES OF SUSPECTED POISONING.

INTERNAL: If the material has been swallowed, induce vomiting immediately. Give a tablespoon of salt in a glass of water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and sleep quiet. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

EXTERNAL: If the material has been spilled on the skin, immediately remove patient from the vicinity of the insecticide, remove all contaminated clothing, and wash skin with soapy and running water. If the material gets into the eyes, wash immediately with running water for at least 10 minutes.
