

FOR CONTROL OF ROOTWORMS AND CERTAIN  
OTHER INSECTS ON CORN

GRASSHOPPERS: For control on fence rows and waste land, use 1/2 to 3/4 pint in sufficient water to cover an acre (10-20 gallons for ground sprayers). Use high dosage for mature hoppers. Do not graze dairy animals on treated area. Allow 90 days after treatment before grazing meat animals that will be finished for slaughter.

SOIL INSECTS IN CORN:

FOR ROOTWORMS: Apply 1 quart per acre as a row spray treatment and 2 quarts per acre for broadcast spraying. Treat just before planting and disc immediately. Row treatment is done at time of planting with nozzles adjusted so sprayed area is covered with soil along with seed.

FOR CORN BILLBUGS, WIREWORMS, SEED CORN MAGGOT, WHITE GRUBS, GREEN JUNE BEETLE LARVAE, as well as CORN ROOTWORMS, make a broadcast application of 1 gallon in sufficient water to cover an acre (3-10 gallons for aerial application, 10-20 gallons for ground application). Apply before planting and disc immediately.

SOIL INSECTS IN OTHER CROPS:

SOYBEANS: For Grape Colapsis, Seed Corn Maggot, White Grubs and Wireworms, apply 1 to 1-1/2 gallons per acre in sufficient water (3-10 gallons for aerial application, 10-20 gallons for ground application), treating soil prior to or at the time of planting. Cover sprayed area with soil immediately.

SMALL GRAINS: BARLEY, OATS, RYE, WHEAT — For White Grubs and Wireworms, treat same as for Soybean insects but as a pre-planting treatment only.

LAWN INSECTS: For Ants, Chigger Ticks, White Grubs and Wireworms, lons of water for 1,000 sq. ft. (1 gal Chiggers, Fleas and Ticks, treat gras into soil for soil insects. Keep ch treated areas until this material is and grass is dry.

pers, and Snap Beans, use 1 to 1-1/4 gallons per acre in  
10 - 20 gallons of water (9 tbsp. in 2 gallons of water per  
1,000 sq. ft.). Spray soil around new sets or seedlings  
before edible parts have started to form. Work into top  
few inches of soil.

**LAWN INSECTS:** For Ants, Chiggers, Earwigs, Fleas,  
Ticks, White Grubs and Wireworms, use 6 tbsp. in 2 gal-  
lons of water for 1,000 sq. ft. (1 gallon per acre). For  
Chiggers, Fleas and Ticks, treat grass and foliage. Wash  
into soil for soil insects. Keep children and pets off  
treated areas until this material is washed into the soil  
and grass is dry.
