DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR FLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND GNATS:

Close doors and windows. Spray freely toward ceiling in all directions until room is filled with mist, then leave the room. Keep doors closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

WASPS:

Application should be made in the late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.
