

DIRECTIONS

This product is an oil soluble concentrate for preparing oil base sprays for the control of grasshop pers in airplane application.

SPRAYS: For the control of grasshoppers in waste lands by airplane application, apply 1% pints per acre for nymphs and 2 pints per acre for admits. Dilute with kerosene or fuel oil to make 2% 5 gallons of spray per acre. Make only one application per season.

Do not allow dairy animals on treated areas. Do not graze meat animals on treated areas within 6 weeks of slaughter. Do not apply to torage to be sold commercially or shipped interstate.

BAITS: For a dry bait on waste lands mix I pint in a gallon of kerosene or fuel oil, and apply in a fine spray to 100 lbs, of coarse, any bran. Thoroughly mix and apply bait at 5 - 19 lbs, per acre. Keep away from livestock.

It is usually more economical to control grasshop pers in waste lands before they move onto crops of economic value.
