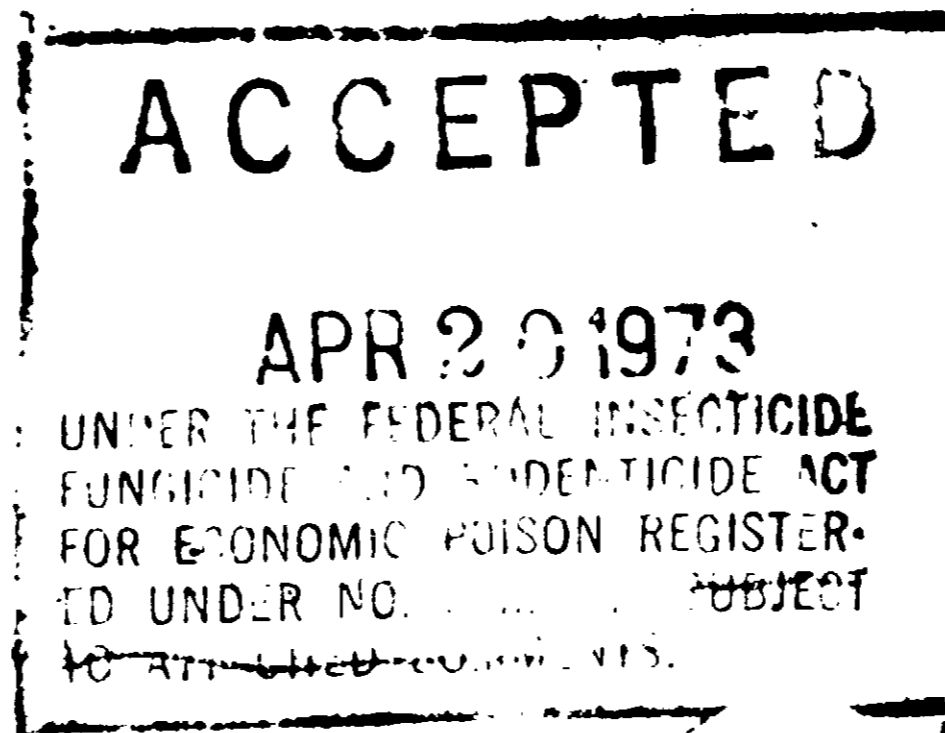


DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

BACK RUBBING DEVICES OR OILERS:
Put Malathion Ready-To-Use Oiler Compound into oiler without any dilution. This treatment will result in a reduction of Horn Flies and Lice. Use one rubbing device to every 35-45 head of cattle. Re-treat the oiler every two or three weeks. Do not use on dairy animals. Do not use on calves less than 3 months old.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing fumes. Avoid contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs. Keep away from children and domestic animals. Malathion, upon repeated or prolonged use, may cause cholinesterase inhibition. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid. Atropine is an antidotal. Destroy container when empty by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Apply this product only as specified on the label.
