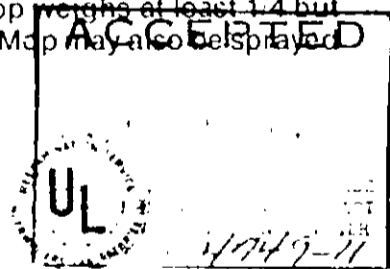

Dust mops to be treated are first cleaned and dried. Impregnate clean dry dust mop to 25-33% by weight treatment retention. Using a postal or baby scale weigh a clean dry mop. Dip mop into Dustrol extract until mop weighs at least 1/4 but not more than 1/3 more than the dry weight of the mop. Mop may also be sprayed until mop attains proper weight.

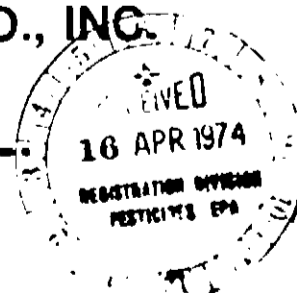
