**CAUTION: DO NOT USE FULL STRENGTH.** Keep out of reach of children. Wear rubber gloves, when handling concentrate. May be fatal if swallowed. Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Do not breathe spray mist or vapor. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Wash thoroughly after handling. Food utensils such as teaspoons or tablespoons should not be used for food purposes after use with pesticides.

Do not use pour, spill or store near heat or open flame. Do not use on nursing puppies. In treating animals be sure to use mineral oil or eye ointment in eyes and zinc oxide ointment or petrolatum on testicles to avoid irritation or burning.

**ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:** Methylated Naphthalenes, 69%; Ronnel O, O-Dimethyl O-(2, 4, 5-trichlorophenyl) phosphorothioate, 15.52%; O, O-Dimethyl O-(2-isopropyl-6-methyl-4-pyrimidinyl) phosphorothioate, 3.79%.

### DIRECTIONS

**TO KILL TICKS:** Use fresh mixture. Add 1 ounce (two tablespoonfuls) to a quart of water or 4 ounces (8 tablespoonfuls) to a gallon of water. Sponge on or dip animal until coat is wet. Rub well into fur, between toes and inside ears. Use once a week if necessary.

**TO KILL FLEAS:** Add 1/2 ounce (1 tablespoonful) to a quart of water, or 2 ounces (4 tablespoonfuls) to a gallon of water. Apply same as for ticks. Allow to dry naturally if badly infested with fleas or ticks.

**TO CLEAN FUR AND SKIN:** Wet coat as directed. Rub off excess moisture. No soap is needed. Do not bathe or rinse just before or just after treating as dilution reduces effectiveness of solution. Use once a week if necessary.

HOLIDAY TICK RID kills fleas in ten minutes and kills ticks in 2 to 6 hours. Ticks usually drop off in a few hours or may be brushed out later. Bathing or dipping young puppies (3 weeks or less) is not recommended.

**TO USE AS A SPRAY:** Use tick mixture as a spray to kill fleas and ticks in kennels, runs or other infested outdoor areas. Spray until surfaces are thoroughly wet.
