Dear Ms. Shinault:

The Agency is responding to the requested amendments to your product's label:

- (1) Inclusion of the statement "Remove dog before treating kennels or runs" under "Directions for Use."
- (2) Revision of the "Environmental Hazards" language to read "Lo not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark."

The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, are acceptable provided that you also:

(1) Change the language under Precautionary Statements/Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals to the following:

"CAUTION: Do not breath dust. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. May be harmful if swallowed. Do not eat, drink, or use tobacco while working with the product. Wash hands and face before eating, drinking, or using tobacco. Avoid contamination of food and feed."
