
Since this product contains petroleum distillates, change the First Aid Statement for If Swallowed to read:

FLEAS WILL BE KILLED IF SHAMPOO IS LEFT ON TEN MINUTES BEFORE RINSING.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Wet fur with water. Apply shampoo, small amounts at a time. Rub in well starting at head and working back. Add more water and more shampoo if needed to make a rich foam lather. Rinse with plain water. Do not reapply product for one week.

When washing cats, kittens or puppies, dry immediately with cloth after rinsing to prevent chilling. Do not use on kittens or puppies under 12 weeks of age. Avoid getting shampoo in animal's eyes. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.
DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
