### ZONE CONTROL

To prevent reoccurrence of fleas, a total management program is recommended. You should treat the areas where fleas live with the HOLIDAY 4-Step Program which consists of: Step 1- Shampoo/Dip the Pet; Step 2- Treat the Home and Yard; Step 3-Flea and Tick Collars on the Pet; Step 4- Maintenance Sprays and Powders. Ask your pet care professional for specific recommendations on how to best control fleas for the comfort and well-being of your pet and family.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### CAUTION

Do not breathe dust. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands after applying. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs. Do not treat puppies or kittens under 12 weeks of age.

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals. However, flea and tick collars may be immediately replaced.

#### FIRST AID

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

**Note to Physicians and Veterinarians:** Product contains cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine should be administered only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition appear.

**IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

### USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- Wear long sleeve shirt, long pants, shoes plus socks and household latex or rubber gloves when applying this product.
- Change clothes as soon as possible after use.
- Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As with any pesticide product, wash hands thoroughly immediately after handling and before eating, smoking or using the toilet.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use product only outside or in a well-ventilated area. Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, dust entire animal, avoiding pet's eyes, nose, mouth and genital areas. Rub or brush pet's hair to work dust down to the skin. This product should not be applied by children. Sprinkle on animal's coat. Rub well into fur starting at head and working back. Be sure to include legs and feet. Sprinkle on pet's bedding. Dust bedding or doghouse using a shaker can or other dust applicator. Do not reapply product for one week.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, nursing animals, or animals on medication. Do not use on pregnant dogs or cats. Do not use on puppies and kittens under twelve weeks of age.

This product is guaranteed to kill ticks and fleas.
