To prevent reoccurrence of fleas, a total management program is recommended. You should treat the areas where fleas live with the HOLIDAY 4-Step Program which consists of: Step 1- Shampoo/Dip the Pet; Step 2- Treat the Home and Yard; Step 3-Flea and Tick Collars on the Pet; Step 4- Maintenance Sprays and Powders. CAUTION

IF IN EYES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. • Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
IF SWALLOWED:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. • Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. • Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. • Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Do not allow children to apply this product and keep children away during application of this product.

Sprinkle on animal's coat. Rub well into fur starting at head and working back. Be sure to include legs and feet. Sprinkle on pet's bedding. Dust bedding or doghouse using a shaker can or other dust applicator. **Do not reapply this product within 30 days.**

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, nursing animals, or animals on medication. Do not use on pregnant dogs or cats. Do not use on puppies and kittens under twelve weeks of age.

This product is guaranteed to kill ticks and fleas.
