The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

1. You must delete "for dogs and cats" from product name. As you were informed in our letter dated November 23, 1992, we cannot accept a label with the additional brand name. You must either change product name to "Holiday Tick Stop for Dogs and Cats", or delete "for dogs and cats" from the product label that is to be accepted.

2. Additional brand "Holiday Tick Stop for Dogs and Cats" is acceptable provided the label for this additional brand name is identical to the accepted label in every respect except for product name and associated art work.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

Sprinkle on animal's coat. Rub well into fur starting at head and working back. Be sure to include legs and feet. Sprinkle on pet's bedding. Use once a week if necessary.
