PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Avoid breathing of dust or repeated contact with skin. Wash hands after applying. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Harmful if swallowed. Do not treat puppies or kittens under 12 weeks of age. Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Note to Physician or Veterinarian: Product contains Cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine should be administered only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition appear.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use product only outside or in a well ventilated area. Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, dust entire animal starting at head and working back, avoiding pet's eyes, nose, mouth and genital areas. Be sure to include legs and feet. Rub or brush pet's hair to work dust down to the skin.

This product should not be applied by children. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, nursing animals, or animals on medication.

Do not use on pregnant dogs or cats. Do not use on kittens or puppies under 12 weeks of age. Do not reapply product for one week.
