For Reg. 4758-78, add FLAMMABLE to the PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARD section based on the reported flame extension for the formulation.

Although we prefer inclusion, you may delete the one sentence-If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you. It is not necessary to file an amendment to delete this one sentence.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **Read all directions before using this product.** Do not spray in enclosed areas. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin.

*Contains twice as much DEET, N,N-diethyl-meta-toluamide, as most aerosol insect repellents.

Be sure to hold can so that spray is directed away from your face and eyes. Hold nozzle of container 6 to 8 inches from pet and spray fur lightly and rub in well to skin. Spray on your hands and apply to pet's face. Avoid contact with the eyes and mouth to prevent temporary stinging sensation. Use whenever the pet may be exposed to Mosquitoes or Biting Flies. Repeat application as needed.

Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash exposed skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.
