The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

It is assumed that your company is in possession of efficacy data to show the product is still effective when the volume treated has been expanded to 6000 cubic feet.

At the next label printing add "Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Increase airing-out time is required for these same areas," in place of "If free flow of mist is not assured in certain areas, there should be an increase in the airing-out time."

CAUTION

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never release contents into a fire or incinerator.

Insecticides may soften some plastics and stain the floor. If used directly over carpet or other floor covering, place in a large pan. Newspaper should be spread on the floor for several feet around area of release.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Refer to Physician. May present aspiration hazard. Product contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine should be administered only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition appear.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes - Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Cover or remove exposed foods, dishes and food handling equipment. All food processing surfaces should be covered immediately prior to treatment or thoroughly cleaned after treatment. Do not use in commercial food establishments. Close doors and windows. Open curtains and doors within the treatment area. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Place at least 6 feet away from pilot light. Fogger should be placed on floor in the middle of the room. Place newspapers under the container to prevent marking surface. Note instructions concerning release from above. Note instructions concerning motor vehicles above. **CAUTION**

1/2" One container for each 600 sq. ft. of unobstructed area. If free flow of mist is not obtained in certain areas, there should be an increase in the spray rate. To start fogging, position fogger on back as shown on the diagram on box and press. Keep at arm's length when releasing. Point top of can away from face and eyes. Set in upright position and leave the building at once. Leave unobstructed for 2 hours. Open doors and windows and allow to air for 1 hour. Do not enter any room where insects, the sack or fogger are or will be present for an extended period of confinement.
