the outside areas.

TO KILL FLEAS ON CATS, & FLEAS & TICKS ON DOGS & PUPPIES
Mix 1/2 oz. (one tablespoon) to a quart of water or 2 oz. (4 table-
spoons) to a gallon of water. USE WARM TAP WATER. MEASURE
ACCURATELY. Mix well. Sponge or sprinkle on, or dip animal until
coat is thoroughly wet. Rub well into fur, between toes and in ears.
For better lasting effects do not rinse but, allow to dry naturally, then
comb and brush if desired. Use once a week if needed.
For faster kill of engorged female ticks on dogs, 1 oz. (2 tablespoons)
to a quart of water or 4 oz. (8 tablespoons) to a gallon of water may
be used.
