
Since this product contains petroleum distillates, change the First Aid Statement for If Swallowed to read:

CAUTION

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Do not use near fire or flame. Contents under pressure. Do not store in direct sunlight or in temperatures above 125° F. do not incinerate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To kill HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, and SAND FLIES direct spray into air allowing about 3 seconds spraying for an average size room, 1,000 cubic feet (10'x10'x10').

To kill ANTS and ROACHES spray into cracks or crevices, under sinks, behind refrigerators, doorsills, window frames, trails, ant hills, into cupboards or any areas where insects may be hiding. Repeat as necessary.

To kill SILVERFISH spray frequently baseboards, door frames, bookcases, and storage areas. Repeat as necessary.

To kill SPIDERS apply spray to the pest and webbing. Repeat as necessary.

To kill TICKS spray directly on pest and liberally spray application to floors, floor covering, bases of walls, and especially around sleeping areas of pets. Pet bedding should be thoroughly treated and allowed to

dry before replacing. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only where temperature will not exceed 125° F

DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
