PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

USE ONLY WHEN AREA TO BE TREATED IS VACATED BY HUMANS AND PETS. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is under way. After space spraying in bakeries, and other food processing plants, wash all equipment with potable water, benches, shelving, where exposed food will be handled. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator. Insecticides may soften some asphalt and solarian tile floors. If used directly over asphalt or solarian tile, place in a large pan. Newspaper should be spread on the floor for several feet around area of release.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If swallowed- Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Note to physician: may present aspiration hazard.
- If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Cover or remove exposed foods, dishes and food handling equipment. In food processing facilities, food should be covered immediately prior to treatment or thoroughly cleaned after treatment. Do not use in commercial food establishments. Close doors and windows. Open cabinets and drawers with the treatment area. Shut off fans and air conditioning. For solarian tile floors, except pilot light, place at least 6 feet away from the pilot light. Place newspaper on floor in the middle of the room. Place newspaper under the canister to prevent staining surface. Note: Do not use in sleeping quarters. Do not use above.

Use one canister for each 12,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. To start fogging, position fog lock actuator as shown on the diagram on box and press. Keep arm's length when releasing. Point top of can away from face and eyes. Set in upright position and leave the building at once. Leave undisturbed for 2 hours. Open doors and windows and allow to air for 1 hour.
