It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product will kill fleas (adults and pre-adult), roaches, houseflies, black carpet beetles, ticks, ants, spiders, flying moths, mosquitos, silverfish, sawtoothed grain beetles, rice weevils, pill bugs, crickets, confused flour beetles, wasps, hornets, and palmetto bugs.

USE ONLY WHEN AREA TO BE TREATED IS VACATED BY HUMANS AND PETS.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover or remove exposed foods, dishes and food

handling equipment. All food processing surfaces should be covered immediately prior to treatment or thoroughly cleaned after treatment.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Remove all motor vehicles before using in garages.

Do not allow children and pets to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. Facilities and equipment in federally inspected meat and poultry plants, bakeries, and other food processing plants, must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse after spraying.

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Open cabinets and doors within the treatment area. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Place at least 6 feet away from pilot light. Fogger should be placed on floor in the middle of the room. Place newspapers under the container to prevent

marring surfaces. Note instructions concerning solarian floors above. To start fogging, position fog-lock activator cap and press. Keep at arm's length when releasing. Point top of can away from face and eyes. Set in upright position and leave the building at once. Leave undisturbed for 2 hours. Open doors and windows and allow to air for 1 hour.
