The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes to the label:

1. According to our files full body immersion is not advisable because it could result in irritation to some areas of the pet's body. Therefore, the **DIRECTIONS FOR USE** must be revised. Remove the statement "Dip animal in mixture". Replace that statement with the language as stated on the previously accepted label.

"Wet animal with water first. Sponge or pour mixture on pet until coat is thoroughly wet."

2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

ZONE CONTROL

DO NOT USE FULL STRENGTH. MIX WITH WATER AS DIRECTED. May cause eye injury. Do not get in eyes, or on clothing. Wear eye protection when mixing concentrate with water. Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Caution should be exercised when using on nursing animals. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 6 weeks of age. Young animals should be towel dried immediately after dipping to prevent chilling. Some individuals and pets may be sensitive to this product. If irritation develops, discontinue use.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Give milk or water, but do not induce vomiting except under medical supervision because of aspiration hazard. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin: Wash off with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation develops.

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.
