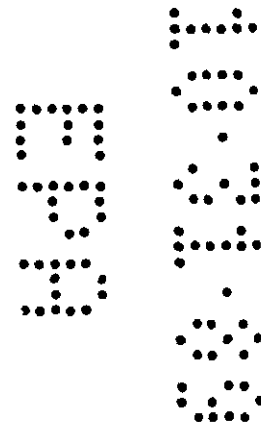

## BACK PANEL

To effectively control fleas, you may be required to treat three insect zones where fleas live. These zones are the pet, the home and the yard. Holiday Non-Aerosol Flea Spray treats the pet insect zone. For treatment of the home and yard, you can buy other Holiday Flea Stop zone control products. Ask your pet care professional for specific recommendations on how to best control fleas for the comfort and well being of your pet and family.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS WARNING

Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. While spraying animal do not get in animal's eyes. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 6 weeks of age. Use with care on nursing animals. Do not use on irritated skin. Some individuals and pets may be sensitive to this product. Discontinue use if irritation develops.

May be used in conjunction with organophosphates and carbamate based insecticides. Does not inhibit acetylcholinesterase activity.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed- Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Contains ethyl alcohol.  
If on skin- Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.  
If in eyes- Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention, if irritation persists.

### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hold pump spray 4-6 inches from animal and direct spray into fur. Rub spray down into fur so that skin is treated and all insects are directly contacted. Be sure to include legs and feet. Spray animal until thoroughly wet but avoid run-off. Do not spray around eyes, on face or on genital area, to avoid irritation. Use spray in well ventilated areas. Do not use more often than once every two days on animal. If pet bedding is heavily flea infested, remove old bedding and replace with fresh; spray may be used to treat bedding.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse container except from refill size of the same product. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
