ZONE CONTROL

To prevent reoccurrence of fleas, a total management program is recommended. You should treat the areas where fleas live with the Zone Control 4-Step Program which consists of: Step 1- Shampoo/Dip the Pet; Step 2- Treat the Home and Yard; Step 3- Flea and Tick Collars on the Pet; and Step 4- Maintenance Sprays and Powders. Ask your pet care professional for specific recommendations on how to best control fleas for comfort and well being of your pet and family.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Applicators of flea and tick spray are to use protective gloves to reduce the risk of dermal irritation or dermal sensitization.

While spraying on animals, do not get in animal's eyes. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication. Do not use on irritated skin. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. Individual animals and pets may exhibit one or more of the following symptoms: hypothermia, tremors, ataxia, excess salivation, agitation and vocalization followed by lethargic behavior, skin and eye irritation in varying degrees. Discontinue use if one or more of the above symptoms develops. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Keep away from heat or open flame.

Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwater or rinsate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hold pump spray 4-6 inches from animal and direct spray into fur. Rub spray down into fur so that skin is treated and all insects are directly contacted. Be sure to include legs and feet. Spray animal until thoroughly wet but avoid run-off. Do not spray around eyes, on face or on genital areas, to avoid irritation. Use spray in well ventilated areas. Do not use on animals under 12 weeks of age. Do not use more often than once every two days on animal. If pet bedding is heavily flea infested, remove old bedding and replace with fresh: spray may be used to treat bedding.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat and open flame.

Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
