above date is acceptable. Please note this CSF will replace
previously accepted ones.

release the product for shipment.

FOOD AREAS - Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups) and serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Pest Control Products F-V-S Crack & Crevice Spray is designed for use in cracks and crevices or surfaces where insects may hide or through which they may enter. Pest Control Products F-V-S Crack & Crevice Spray is compatible with the 3 & G Aerosol dispensing unit.

Crawling Insects: Cockroaches, Water Bugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish Beetles, Centipedes, Longhorns, Millipedes, Spiders, Pill Bugs, Sow Bugs. Apply small amounts directly into cracks using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide in points between different construction elements, between equipment and floor, openings leading to voids or hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, in conduits, motor housings, junction or switch boxes. Prior to application allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing pellets in "ON" position. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Ticks, Fleas, Bed Bugs and Carpet Beetles: Spray cracks and crevices in baseboards, door frames, window frames or such places where above insects may hide. Moldings and all cracks and crevices in the room should also be treated. For control in kennels or outdoor dog houses. Remove animals during treatment and allow area to dry before re-entry.

Ants: Spray into points of entry around doors, baseboards, windows or structural cracks and crevices.

Stored-Product Insects: Treat infested areas such as cracks and crevices between elements of construction, equipment junctions, cabinets or openings to voids. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Wood-Destroying Insects: For localized control of carpenter ants, carpenter bees, and powder-post beetles. Locate the source of infestation and spray into funnels, holes and cavities.

SERVING AREAS - Facilities where foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. Apply as spot treatment to selective surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.)

NON-FOOD AREAS - Including garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes. Surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Repeat treatment as required. For control of fleas and ticks in kennels or outdoor dog houses. Spray all floor surfaces, cracks and crevices no higher than twelve inches.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
