Long lasting fragrance gives the animal a fresh, clean smell.

ZONE CONTROL: To prevent reoccurrence of fleas, a total management program is recommended. You should treat the areas where fleas live with the 4-Step Program which consists of: Step 1- Shampoo/Dip the Pet; Step 2- Treat the Home and Yard; Step 3- Flea and Tick Collars on the Pet; Step 4- Maintenance Sprays and Powders. Ask your pet care professional for specific recommendations on how to best control fleas for the comfort and well being of your pet and family.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear safety glasses. Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals or animals on medication.

Wet dog or cat with warm water and apply small amount of shampoo along the back of the animal. Wear gloves and work into the coat well, starting at head and working back. Note: Contact with pesticides by applicators is not advisable; therefore, instead of rubbing the shampoo into the fur of animals with hands, use of a brush is recommended. Be sure to include feet and legs. When lather is of desired consistency, continue to work into coat for 5 minutes to kill fleas. Rinse thoroughly with warm water. May be diluted up to 1:3 (1 part shampoo with 3 parts water) as desired. Do not reapply product for one week.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
