Contains petroleum distillate- vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Attach hose-end sprayer to hose. Remove cap from bottle and attach sprayer to bottle. Turn on water. To activate insecticide, place finger over hole on top of sprayer. Spray uniformly over lawn and other infested areas, especially in areas frequented by pets. Spray from about three feet above surface moving at a steady pace to insure consistent, thorough coverage.

To stop insecticide flow, simply remove finger from over siphoning hole. To store balance of unused insecticide, remove sprayer and replace cap. Store in a cool, safe place away from children and pets.

NOTE: For best results (although not necessary), area to be treated should be wet. Spraying hard first with just water or spraying yard spray after rain will increase activity of product. During hot weather, spraying in early evening, just before dark, will yield better results.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**DISPOSAL:** If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
