PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. May cause allergic skin reaction. Wear gloves when using this product to bathe dogs. Excessive or prolonged contact of the dip solution with the skin should be avoided. Contaminated utensils should not be used for food purposes after use with insecticides. Do not treat sick or debilitated animals or animals under 4 months of age. Do not treat nursing animals.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a Physician or Poison Control Center at once. Drink milk or water and induce vomiting by sticking finger down back of throat.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and water, remove contaminated clothing.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine Sulfate by injection is antidotal only if signs of cholinesterase inhibition are present.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and wildlife. Do not apply directly to lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use on Dogs, to kill Fleas, Ticks, and Mange Mites, dilute two ounces of Dog Dip to 1 gallon of water (8 oz. to 4 gallons) and mix well. Dip or sponge animals until the hair coat is thoroughly wet to the skin. Do not rinse. Allow solution to dry on animals. Do not repeat treatment more often than once every 4 weeks. Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals. Do not use on cats. Do not use full strength.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not reuse container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
