Precautionary STATEMENTS

HAZARDS to HUMANS and DOMESTIC ANIMAL

DIRECTIONS for USE :

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
Use at a rate of 3 fluid ounces per gallon of water for each 1000 square feet. For control of fleas, thoroughly apply a fine particle broadcast spray, using 3 ounce per gallon of water dilution to infested Rugs, Carpets and Pet Resting Areas. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray Pet with this Product. Do not use full strength.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

Storage : Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

Pesticide Disposal : Pesticide spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label directions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or Local procedures.

Container Disposal : Do not reuse empty container. WRAP empty container in several layers of newspaper and DISCARD in Trash.
