On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is unconditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5). Once a pesticide is registered, however, it is not regarded as permanently acceptable. Registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. the Agency determines that, at any time, additional data are required to maintain in effect an existing registration, the Agency will require submission of such data under FIFkA section (3)(c)(2)(B).

- 1. Make the following label changes:
  - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 4758-163".
  - b. In the directions for use with respect to ticks, mites and lice, delete the word "rapid." Data support claim for rapid control of fleas only.
  - c. Add the following statement to the directions for use:

"Do not use on old, sick or debilitated animals."

d. Delete the claim "Residual control of fleas up to eight days." Efficacy data submitted does not support the claim and it is also in conflict with the statement "repeat treatment in 3 days if necessary."

- e. Delete the phrase "Contains the Botanically-Derived Insecticide: Linarcol." Statements relative to composition indirectly implying safety of the product are not acceptable.
- f. Under "IF ON SKIN" revise second statement to read "Get medical attention if symptoms or irritation develop."
- g. Revise Environmental Hazards Statement to read as follows:

"This pesticide is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of washwaters. Apply this product only as specified on the labeling."

- With respect to the product name "Flea Stop" I h. reiterate my earlier opinion that the word "Stop" is misleading in that it implies a cessation of a flea problem on animals when in fact the product will only control fleas for a specific period of time in fact for possibly only 3 days as currently labeled. In addition the name is also misleading in that it implies flea control when in fact the product claims control of other pests. While I understand your reasoning, I am not persuaded to change my previous position that the term is unacceptable. However, since you stated that "FLEA STOP" is a brand name in your product line, I would not object to the name "Flea Stop Brand." This qualifier should adequately characterize the term Flea stop as a brand name and as such no longer misleading.
- 2. Submit three copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
