On long-haired dogs, rub your fingers through the ruffled hair directly over the ticks. Repeat spray thoroughly wets ticks. R

**PUPPIES**

Spray back of pet only, then rub into animal's coat and around

**KENNELS OR PET**

Apply thoroughly to infested quarters, nearby cracks and baseboards, window and door frames and floor covering where fleas and ticks may be present. Old pet bedding should be removed after treatment of pet before allowing them to enter. Avoid spraying where spotting, staining, objectionable

**HORSES**

To control stable flies, horses, remove excess dirt from legs and areas commonly attacked by flies. Cloth with spray and rub on face and eyes. Repeat treatment as needed.
