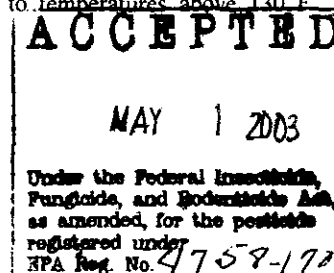

FIRST AID	
IF SWALLOWED:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.• Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.• Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.• Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Move person to fresh air.• If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.• Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Take off contaminated clothing.• Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.• Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

ZONE CONTROL

To prevent reoccurrence of fleas, a total management program is recommended. You should treat the areas where live with the Holiday 4-Step Program which consists of: Step 1- Shampoo/Dip the pet; Step 2- Treat the home and Yard; Step 3- Flea and Tick Collars on the Pet; Step 4- Maintenance Sprays and Powders. Ask your pet care professional for Specific recommendations on how to best control fleas for the comfort and well being of your pet and family.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE ONLY IN A WELL VENTILATED AREA

DOGS AND CATS

Spray at a distance of 6-12 inches by squeezing the trigger repeatedly and rapidly. Cover animals eyes with hand and with a firm fast stroke, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face and around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finish legs last.

For best results, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long-haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Do not repeat treatment for one week.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.

PUPPIES AND KITTENS

Spray back of pet only, then spray on your fingertips and rub into animal's coat and around mouth, nose and eyes. Do not use on animals under 12 weeks of age.

KENNELS OR PET SLEEPING QUARTERS

Apply thoroughly to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door sills, and localized areas of floor and floor covering where fleas, ticks, and lice may be present. Old pet bedding should be removed and replaced with fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Treat pets with product before allowing them to enter treated area. Do not spray surfaces where spotting, staining, or discoloration would be objectionable.

HORSES AND PONIES

To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies, remove excess dirt from legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. To treat face, dampen a cloth with spray and rub on face and head, being careful to avoid eyes. Repeat treatment as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Store in a dry area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
