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

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using.

One 16 [20] ounce canister contains enough powder to treat 1 to 2 rooms [2 to 3 rooms] (200 - 400 square feet) [250 - 500 square feet]. When using this product at the lower rate, allow the powder to remain in place for 24 hours before vacuuming. Apply powder more heavily to areas of flooring or furniture on which pets spend most of their time. Apply to dry surfaces only. Do not wet powder.

Carpets: Shake powder evenly across surface. Brush lightly with broom to force powder deep into carpet where fleas and their larvae exist. Wait at least 60 minutes before (lightly) vacuuming to remove visible surface powder. For maximum efficacy, delay vacuuming for up to 24 hours.

Upholstery: Remove loose cushions. Sprinkle along creases and into corners. Brush lightly to work powder into folds and creases. Vacuum to remove visible powder on surfaces. Do not use on exposed fabric without first testing on a hidden surface for effects on color (staining) or texture. If powder adheres to a spot, brush out and vacuum that area immediately.

When emptying vacuum bag after use, wrap contents or disposable bag in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Treat pets with a registered flea and tick control product prior to re-entry.


We are submitting this notification to add clarification language to the label in regard to a larger canister size of the product and the relevant increase in coverage area. This is based on a 25% increase in the current 16 oz. product size to 20 oz. This is being done due to a request from one of our supplemental distributors who wish to sell the product in a 20 oz. bonus size canister when they market the product.

This does not negate the original coverage determination and calculation because it still calculates at 1 oz. of powder per 25 sq. ft. at the lower application rate and 1 oz of powder per 12.5 sq. ft. at the higher application rate.

This label change should fall under the guidelines of 98-10 Notifications Section II. E. Changes in Packaging and Related Labeling Statements and also Section II. M. 1 a. regarding changes in the Directions For Use to accommodate a larger size, provided the dilution ratio remains constant.
