The amendment referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act is acceptable.

However at the next printing of your label the following comments should be added to the label:

- a. Revise the statement "Concentrate is alkaline. Harmful if taken internally. Concentrate is an eye irritant. Eye damage may occur from contact with concentrate. Concentrate is a primary skin irritant. A reversible skin irritation (redness and swelling) may occur from contact with the concentrate. Avoid all contact with eyes or prolonged skin contact". To read "Causes eye damage and skin irritation, Do not get into eye on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed".
- b. Revise the statement "First Aid: In case of eye contact, flush with running water for 15 minutes. Call a physician. In case of skin contact, wash immediately with water. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Dilute with water or milk. Immediately contact physician and obtain treatment". To read "In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For

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eyes call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed drink promptly plenty of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.
