CHLORMADANE

FOR CONTROL OF TICKS, LICE, FLEAS, AND SARCOPTIC AND DEMODECTIC MANGE OF DOGS

DIRECTIONS

For Fleas and Lice: Add 2 ounces (4 tablespoonfuls) Chlormacane to 1 gallon of water. Animal should first be bathed with soap and water, rinsed and toweled. Apply the diluted Chlormacane solution with sponge or cloth or by dipping and allow the animal to dry without toweling. To prevent reinfestation, repeat application every 2 to 3 weeks.

For Ticks: Add 4 ounces (8 tablespoonfuls) Chlormadane to 1 yallon of water and follow above directions.

Since diagnosis of demodectic mange is often difficult, and treatment may involve other factors such as diet, treatment should be done by or under direction of a veterinarian.
