The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

- 1) Change the statement, "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes", to read "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash waters."
- 2) Add the statement, "IF IN EYES: Wash eyes with plenty of water. If irritation persists contact a physician."

A stamped copy of the draft label is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of the corrected finished label before the product is released for shipment under this revised labeling.
