

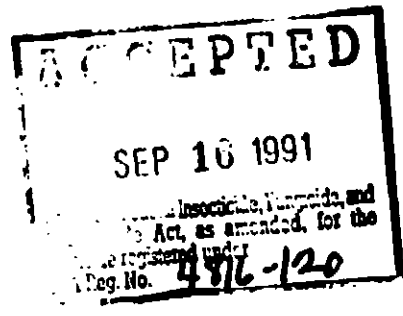

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product may be used for the formulation of end use products intended for the following acceptable uses:
Terrestrial Food Crops, Terrestrial Nonfood Crops, Greenhouse Vegetables and Ornamentals, Aquatic Pisciciding, Domestic Pets and their premises, Indoor (Household), Domestic Outdoor (Household/Ornamental), Commercial/Industrial Uses, Animal Treatments and holding areas, Livestock, and uncultivated nonagricultural sites.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
PESTICIDE STORAGE AND PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperature. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.
CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local

procedures.

CONTAINERS ONE GALLON AND SMALLER: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by tickling back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas of skin with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing with soap and water before reuse.

This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit.
