This product may be used for the formulation of end use products intended for the following acceptable uses: Terrestrial Food Crops, Terrestrial Nonfood Crops, Greenhouse Vegetables and Ornamentals, Aquatic Pisciciding, Domestic Pets and their premises, Indoor (Household), Domestic Outdoor (Household/Ornamental), Commercial/Industrial Uses, Animal Treatments and holding areas, Livestock, and uncultivated nonagricultural sites.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperature. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.
