Dri-Die kills insects on contact through a physico-chemical action. It is odorless, non-staining, may be used anywhere in the home, factory, or other site without damaging materials of any kind. It kills roaches on contact, protects against entrance of dry wood termites into buildings.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**Dry Wood Termites** - Use an electric or hand-operated rotary duster to distribute Dri-Die through an entry, e.g. crawl hole into the attic and the crawl space of the building. Rate of application is recommended at one (1) pound per 1,000 sq. feet of floor area. All wood surfaces must be covered. All vents and louvers on the windward side to be closed.

**Roaches** (German, Brown-Banded, Oriental) - Distribute Dri-Die at the rate of 2 ounces per 100 sq. feet of floor area in visible concentration beneath and behind appliances, e.g. refrigerator, stoves. Apply a continuous visible film on and behind all moldings, holding edges, around pipe openings, in cracks and crevices where the insect may hide. On severe infestation apply Dri-Die in crawl spaces, attics, behind baseboards at the rate of 16 ounces per 1,000 sq. feet of floor area. Repeat as necessary.

**New Construction** - To help prevent infestation, apply Dri-Die on masonry, concrete, or part of all outer walls. Make sure all pipe penetrations are treated. If plaster walls, holes may be made with a drill. After treatment, holes are closed by plastering or other means.

# SPECIMEN LABEL

**DISPOSE OF WASTES** by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Container should be disposed of by burying with wastes or by burning. Keep out of smoke.

**Fleas - Dogs and Cats** - Liberally apply powder to the animal, rubbing thoroughly to the skin. Begin with the neck and include the underbody, legs, feet, and the base of the tail. Repeat as necessary. Surfaces of kennels should be dusted at rate of one ounce per 50 square feet. Heavily infested kennel basements and crawl spaces should be dusted at rate of 16 ounces per 1,000 sq. feet. Repeat as necessary.
