Amendment - Label Revisions Subject: Dri-Die^R Insecticide EPA Registration No. 4816-240 Your Application Dated December 13, 1990

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

Please replace the heading and Precautionary Statement 1. section on your current label as it appears on the last stamped accepted labeling dated January 17, 1983 with the following revision:

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

2. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement as follows:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

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Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

The current basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated May 22, 1977 for your product does not meet the label claim for the active ingredient and inert ingredients. Please submit an updated CSF reflecting any formulation changes. Enclosed is a CSF for your convenience.

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

It is odorless, non-staining and may be used in dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls, along and behind baseboards, beneath and behind sinks, stairs refrigerators and cabinets; around plumbing and other utility installations; without damaging materials of any kinds. It kills *Cockroaches*, after contact and prevents new infestations of *Drywood Termites* in buildings.

To aid in the Prevention of Drywood Termites and Rat Mites:

Use an electric or hand operated rotary duster to distribute Dri-Die[®] through an entry crawl hole into attics, crawl spaces and other infested areas of buildings. Rate of application is recommended at 1 pound per 1000 square feet of floor area. All wood surfaces must be covered. All vents and louvers on the windward side should be closed.

Apply between studding in lower part of all outer walls. Make sure all spaces between studs are treated. In plaster walls, holes may be made with a drill. After treatments, holes are closed by plasterers when taping.

Liberally apply powder to the animal, rubbing thoroughly into the skin. Begin with the neck and include the underbody, legs, feet and base of the tail. Repeat as necessary.
