Subject: Amendment - Addition of Tank Mixing with Boric Acid
Dri-Die® Insecticide
EPA Registration No. 4816-240
Your Application Dated October 19, 1992

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Add the following statement at the end of the tank mixing instructions:

This product cannot be mixed with any product containing a label prohibition against such mixing.

2. Since this product is intended for use by commercial applicators only, as indicated in your letter, add the following statement to the front label panel:

For Commercial/Industrial Use Only

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Dri-Die kills insects after contact through a physiochemical action. It is odorless, non-staining and may be used in dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls, along and behind baseboards, beneath and behind sinks, stairs, refrigerators and cabinets; around plumbing and other utility installations without damaging materials

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Under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, for the pesticide registered under EPA Reg. No. 4816-240

of any kind. It kills *Cockroaches*, after contact and prevents new infestations of *Drywood Termites* in buildings.

To aid in the Prevention of Drywood Termites and Rat Mites: Use an electric or hand operated rotary duster to distribute Dri-Die through an entry crawl hole into attics, crawl spaces and other infested areas of buildings. Rate of application is recommended at 1 pound per 1000 square feet of floor area. All wood surfaces must be covered. All vents and louvers on the windward side should be closed.

To Kill Infestations of Cockroaches (German, Brown-banded, Oriental): Distribute Dri-Die at the rate of 2 ounces per 100 square feet of floor area in visible concentration beneath and behind appliances, refrigerators and stoves. Apply a continuous visible film on and behind oil moldings, shelving edges, around pipe openings and in cracks and crevices where insects may hide. On severe infestations, apply Dri-Die in crawl spaces, attics, behind walls and cabinets at the rate of 16 ounces per 1000 square feet of floor area. Repeat as necessary.

New Constructions - To Aid in the Prevention of Drywood Termites and Cockroaches: Apply between studding in lower part of all outer walls. Make sure all spaces between studs are treated. In plaster walls, holes may be made with a drill. After treatments, holes are closed by plasterers when taping.

In Combination with Boric Acid: Dri-Die may be mixed with Boric Acid at the rate of from 1 part by volume Boric Acid : 4 parts by volume Dri-Die to 4 parts by volume Boric Acid : 1 part by volume Dri-Die. The applicator must add the proper amounts of each product together in either a power or hand duster and thoroughly agitate. Applications must be made in accordance with the more restrictive of label limitations and precautions. No label dosage may be exceeded.

Dogs and Cats - To Kill Infestations of Fleas: Liberally apply powder to the animal, rubbing thoroughly into the skin. Begin with the neck and include the underbody, legs, feet and base of the tail. Repeat as necessary.

Carpenter Ants: For effective control, locate and treat nests and surrounding areas at a rate of 3 ounces per 100 square feet. Apply around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises and where they crawl and hide. Also force dust into infested wood through existing openings or newly drilled small holes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage And Spill: Store at room temperature. Keep up and dispose of with care. **Disposal:** Pesticide, spray mixture be used according to label instructions of at or by an approved waste disposal authority. **Disposal:** Completely empty tapping sides and bottom of container into application of container in a sanitary land by State and local authorities cannot be reused, dispose of One Pound And Smaller containers in several layers of trash.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICE

IF SWALLOWED: Drink water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Contact physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting or give any medicine to unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Administer artificial respiration if indicated. **IF IN EYES OR ON SKIN:** Wash with water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

PRECAUTIONS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

Avoid inhalation of dust.

Do not use in food/feed preparation areas, restaurants or other areas where food is prepared or processed. Do not use in food storage areas where food is exposed or facility where food is prepared or processed but excluding areas where food is stored or held.

In the home, cover all food and remove all food and cooking utensils after treatment. Exposed food should be removed.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water or washwaters.
