This product is a finely divided powder which combines the flushing and killing powers of pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide with the dehydrative principle of thermally attrited hydrogel. It is relatively odorless and non-staining and may be used in accordance with directions in home, restaurants, stores, hotels, offices, plants and warehouses. When used as directed, it is highly effective in controlling such insects as ants, roaches, silverfish, bed bugs, fleas, lice, ticks and dry wood termites.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To control such running and crawling insect life as ants, cockroaches, silverfish, and fleas in animal quarters, distribute Drione at the rate of 2 ounces per 100 square feet of surface area. Apply a continuous visible film underneath and behind stoves, refrigerators, and appliances. Treat on and behind moulding, shelving, baseboards, pipe openings, cracks, crevices and other areas where insects may hide. For severe infestations apply Drione behind cabinets and walls in crawl spaces and attics at the rate of 10 ounces per 1000 square feet of surface area. Repeat treatment as necessary.

SEWER TREATMENTS

American and Oriental cockroach infestations in sanitary sewers may be treated with approximately 1 1/2 lbs. Drione per manhole. When treating sewers, one manhole per 200 feet of line should be treated. Treatment is made by removing the manhole cover and replacing with a disc of plywood bored to receive the usual flexible hose from posthole to the connected venting opening. A one-way cover which will hold about 1 1/2 lbs. of Drione. The insecticide is introduced into the venting pipe to be dispersed through and thoroughly through the system.

BED BUGS

Take bed apart. Dust into joints and channels. If hollow, such as square or round tubing, see that the interior of framework is well dusted. Mattress should be dusted, especially tufts, folds and edges. Picture frame moldings and all cracks and crevices in the room should be treated.

DRY WOOD TERMITES

These termites are restricted to certain parts of the country and should not be confused with Subterranean termites. Use an electric or hand operated rotary duster to distribute Drione through an entry, e.g., crawl hole into the attic and the crawl space of the building. Rate of application is recommended at one (1) pound per 1,000 square feet of floor area. All wood surfaces must be covered. All vents and louvers on the windward side to be closed.

FLEAS - Dogs and Cats

Liberal apply powder to the animal, rubbing thoroughly to the skin. Begin with the neck and include the underbody, legs, feet, and the base of the tail. Repeat as necessary. Surface coat control should be dusted at rate of one ounce per 50 square feet. Heavily infested layers, basements, and crawl spaces should be dusted at rate of 10 ounces per 1000 square feet. Repeat as necessary.
