

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To control Fleas and Lice on dogs.

Remove protective cap, hold container upright, nozzle away from you. With nozzle 10 to 12 inches away, direct spray over the animal. Beginning at the tail, spray over the animal until the entire coat is damp up to back of neck. On long-haired dogs, ruffle the coat and spray against the lay of hair, spraying directly behind hand so that spray reaches skin. Avoid spraying face and scrotum. An application of 30 to 45 seconds is usually sufficient for an average size dog. Repeat application weekly if necessary. Note: Do not treat or cause exposure of puppies less than four weeks old.

For best results in controlling tick infestations, locate ticks and spray directly on them.

In kennels or other sleeping quarters to control these insects and to deodorize the quarters, spray the animal regularly as above and spray bedding, walls, cracks, crevices and flooring as often as necessary.

Caution: Avoid breathing of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin; wash thoroughly after use. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs.

WARNING: Flammable! Contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, sparks, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.
