## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its  
labeling.

### APPLICATIONS WITHIN FOOD AREAS:

Food processing plants and warehouses, bakeries, beverage plants, restaurants, super-  
markets, meat and poultry processing plants, hotels, motels, hospitals, and schools.  
Limit to Crack and Crevice Treatment Only:

Using a bulbous duster apply a small amount of material directly into cracks and  
crevices such as expansion joints between different elements of construction or  
between equipment bases and the floor, wall voids, motor housing, junction boxes or  
switch boxes, conduits or hollow equipment legs where cockroaches, ants, silverfish,  
spiders, boxelder bugs, and crickets hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing

### NON-FOOD AREAS:

Homes, institutions, hospitals, office buildings, hotels, motels, theaters,

cockroaches, silverfish, firebrats, spiders, boxelder bugs, ticks, lice, and  
animal quarters, distribute Drione at the rate of 2 ounces per 100 square

appliances. Treat on, around and behind moldings, shelving, baseboard  
openings, cracks, crevices, and other areas where insects hide. For severe

### STORED PRODUCT PESTS:

To aid in the control of cadellies, cheese mites, cigarette beetles, confu-  
beetles, dark meal worms, drugstore beetles, grain mites, granary weevil  
beetles, rice weevils, sawtoothed grain beetles and yellow meal worms

### BEES AND WASPS:

It is generally advisable to treat wasp and bee nests in the evening when

surrounding areas where insects alight. Nests in wall voids can be located  
with your ear against the wall. Drill a hole in the area, blow dust in, and  
ground wasps, dust entrance and surrounding areas. For best results close  
carefully one or two days after treatment to ensure complete kill, then re-  
destroy nest to prevent emergence of newly-hatched insects. If removal is  
feasible, retreat the nest, if necessary. Do not use this product to treat

### SEWER TREATMENTS:

American and Oriental cockroach infestations in sanitary sewers may be  
approximately 6 ounces of Drione per manhole. When treating sewers,  
per 200 feet of line should be treated. Treatments are made by removing  
cover and replacing with a disc of plywood bored to receive the usual flange  
from portable or truck-mounted ventilating equipment. 6 ounces of Drione

### BEDBUGS:

Take bed apart. Dust into joints and channels. If hollow, such as square

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## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
